

## 22 1859-01-19: Letter

Grinnell, Jan. 19th, 1859

Sister Sarah

I received a letter from Collins yesterday of Jan 6th saying there were no Notes enclosed and that I did not say whether I received the check. I received the Check of \$517 but the Notes I forgot to send because I was in a hurry to send the letter by the Stage that night. I am glad they were forgotten because there would have been two mortgage deeds! The deeds were received for record on Jan 4th?. I send for them this week and if they are recorded I will send the mortgage deed as soon as I get it. We are all well and hope to you all the same. Caper is fat. He boards over to Craine's (?) every day. I think I have explained everything. We have a great donation party next Friday night for the Baptist Minister at the Hotel, and everybody in town is going.
