they've taken the radio man and bombardier from our crew, so now we have just 4 of the original outfit left. Of course we were sorry to see them go, but there isn't much to be done about it.

From today's paper, it looks as if they're going to run into a little trouble driving the Germans out of Italy! Also I noticed that Nile Kinnick was killed -

My day off this week comes tomorrow - I'm not decided what to do as yet. I don't think I'll go very far this time.
