Mazahir Salih made history when she was elected to the Iowa City city council in 2017, becoming the first Muslim to be elected in the city and the first Sudanese-American to be elected to a public office in the country. Salih, activist and co-founder of the Center for Worker Justice of Eastern Iowa, will be speaking about her candidacy, why she decided to run, and the issues important to her as an Iowan and an American.
